BEST TIME TO GO SAFARI

January, February & March – Witness millions of wildebeest give birth in the southern plains of the Serengeti, closely followed by predators. Less crowds and reduced rates.

April & May – many camps close due to the long rains

June, July, August, September witness the migration crossing the river from the Serengeti into the Masai Mara.

October, November the migration returns to the Serengeti and start to move from the Northern Serengeti, down to the Central and onto the Southern Plains
