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BEST TIME TO GO SAFARI

The dry season runs from May to October and is the best time to go on safari with pleasant daytime temperatures.

Some camps close during the rainy season. (December to April) and is commonly called the "Green Season" as the bush is thick and green.

The best time to view the Victoria Falls on the is at the end of rainy season, end March to May when the Zambezi River is in full flood and the falls are at their most spectacular

It is also a great time to do white river rafting when the water levels are low or take a take a dip in the Devil's Pool.



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
