Southampton - Oslo - Copenhagen (2 days) - Tallin - St Petersburg (3 days) - Helsinki - Skagen - Southampton

Day 1: Southampton UK. Embark on Royal Caribbean's Independence of the Seas on our Crafty Adventure at Sea cruise with Jenny Doan and Sue Daley. Settle in to your cabin and explore the ship, and then meet your fellow Crafty Adventurers and hosts for a welcome event in the evening. Join us for dinner, and then enjoy the entertainment onboard, or relax in one of the many bars and lounges on the ship.

Day 2: At Sea. Today we will meet in the conference room onboard where we will start working on our cruise projects. There will also be free time to enjoy the many activities offered on the ship. Enjoy dinner, and then maybe catch a show in the theatre.

Day 3: Oslo - Norway. Today we will visit the spectacular city of Oslo. Wander around the historic city, or maybe book a shore tour to visit the stunning fjords.

Days 4-5: Copenhagen - Denmark. We have 2 days to relax and explore wonderful Copenhagen. Visit the beautiful Tivoli Gardens, the Royal Palace, the Little Mermaid, or maybe join a tour to visit Hamlet's Castle. You can also travel across the bridge that connects Denmark and Sweden and visit another beautiful Scandinavian country.

Day 6: At Sea. Another relaxing day at sea to join your fellow crafters along with Jenny and Sue in the conference centre to work on our projects.

Day 7: Tallin - Estonia Tallin is sure to be a highlight of the cruise with its medieval heritage. You can wander around the Old Town which is listed by UNESCO as the best preserved Old Town in Europe and is still enclosed by circular stone walls.

Days 8-10: St Petersburg - Russia. We have 3 full days to explore one of the most beautiful cities in the world. St Petersburg is home to so much history, and is an architectural masterpiece. Visit palaces, beautiful gardens, cruise the canals, and explore the spectacular Hermitage Museum. You could also enjoy a Russian ballet performance, and don't forget to take a trip on the local metro with their stunning marble and chandeliers. These are 3 days you will never forget!

Day 11: Helsinki - Finland. Helsinki is another beautiful Scandinavian city. It is very compact and perfect to explore on foot. The cobble stoned streets are full of history, and many beautiful islands and a historic fort are easily accessed from the port.

Day 12: At Sea. Enjoy a relaxing day back onboard the ship and continue working on our projects. Jenny and Sue will also present several lectures onboard so you can get to know them, learn their stories, as well as lots of new skills.

Day 13: Skagen - Denmark. Our final port visit is Skagen - a port town on the northern end of the Jutland peninsula, and a Danish seaside playground with white sandy beaches. Day 14: At Sea. Our final day at sea and a chance to relax and reflect on a fabulous journey with many new friends and wonderful memories. Join us for a farewell dinner, and some special awards.
