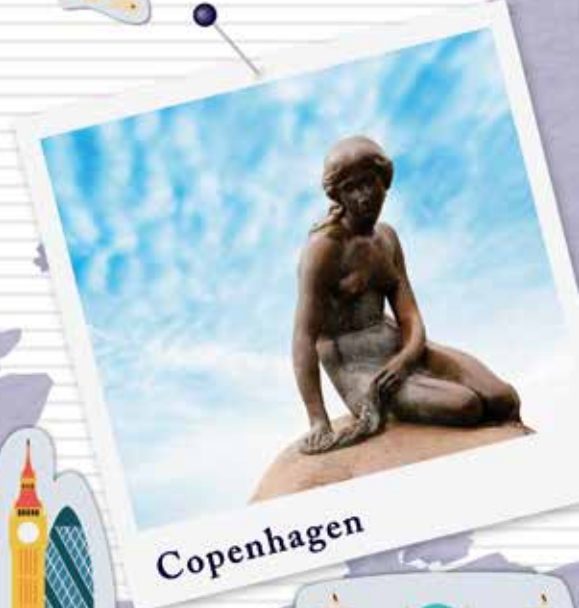

# TOP PLACES TO

## BARCELONA, SPAIN

Barcelona is Spain's second largest city, with a population of over two million people, and the capital of Catalonia. The many faces of Barcelona include the medieval Old Town, and the unique street grid resulting from 19th-century urban planning. It is also famous for a number of prominent buildings, of which the most-known are by the architect Antonio Gaudi, including his Sagrada Família, which became Barcelona's symbol to many and after 135 years, is still yet to be completed.

## COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

A million Danes call Copenhagen home, including Australia's own, Princess Mary. This "friendly old girl of a town" is big enough to be a metropolis with shopping, culture and excellent nightlife, but still small enough to be intimate and easy to navigate. Overlooking the Øresund strait with Sweden just minutes away, Copenhagen is a cultural and geographic link between mainland Europe and Scandinavia. This is where old fairy tales blend with flashy new architecture. A visit to The Little Mermaid and Tivoli Gardens is a must.

## DUBROVNIK, CROATIA

Dubrovnik is a stunning walled city on the Adriatic Sea. Although its population barely exceeds 40,000, it's one of the most prominent tourist resorts of the Mediterranean and is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Regardless of whether you are visiting Dubrovnik for the first time or the hundredth, the sense of awe never fails to descend when you set eyes on the beauty of the old town. It's hard to imagine anyone becoming jaded by the city's white limestone streets, baroque buildings and the endless shimmer of the Adriatic.

## REYKJAVIK, ICELAND

Reykjavik is the capital and largest city of Iceland. It is the centre of culture and life of the Icelandic people as well as being one of the focal points of tourism in Iceland.
