Rome - Pompeii- Amalfi Coast- Siena- Florence- Bologna- Venice

Day 1 - 9 May – Depart Perth

onboard Emirates flight to Rome via Dubai.

Day 2 – 10 May Rome Upon arrival in Rome, transfer to your hotel and check-in. Use your 48 hour Hop-On Hop-Off bus pass to see all the city's highlights. A map and audio guide are included to give you an explanation of the main sights. Welcome dinner and overnight at the hotel. (D)

Day 3 - 11 May – Rome After breakfast private transfer to the Colosseum where we will take in the still-standing arcades and battle-staging areas of The Colosseum; the old markets and political arenas of the Roman Forum; and the remnants of emperor's palaces and gardens at Palatine Hill—all with special Skip-the-Line access that lets you spend your time sightseeing, rather than waiting in entry queues. Guiding you will be an English-speaking expert in Roman history, whose knowledge helps bring these ancient sites to vibrant life. Free time after the tour to explore Rome using your hop on/off bus pass. (B)

Day 4 - 12 May – Rome After breakfast private transfer to discover the treasures of the Vatican City!

Our private guide will give you an overview of the history and the art of Rome before entering the Vatican Museums where you will admire ancient masterpieces before visiting

the Sistine Chapel with its famous frescos. After it, you'll have the chance to admire the stunning S. Peter's Basilica, the biggest church in the world. Free time after the tour to enjoy a gelato and people watch. (B)

Day 5 - 13 May – Rome to Sorrento

This morning board the bus to Sorrento. On the way stop in Pompeii for a tour of its excavations: get touched by the dramatic story of the Roman city destroyed and buried by the eruption of the Vesuvius in 79 AD. After the guided tour you will proceed to Sorrento. Check in and overnight in your hotel. (B)

Day 6 – 14 May – Sorrento

Free Day * Optional excursion to Isle of Capri. (B)

Day 7 – 15 May – Sorrento Today is dedicated to the discovery of the Amalfi Coast, the stretch of coastline south of Naples, renowned for its exceptional beauty and iconic medieval cliffside fishing villages. Lemon groves and sprawling summer villas cling to the steep cliffs that lead to sparkling blue water. In the afternoon come back to your hotel in Sorrento. (B)

Day 8 – 16 May - Sorrento to Siena

After breakfast, we travel to Siena . Check in your hotel and enjoy afternoon at leisure. (B)

Day 9 – 17 May – Siena

Today explore the exciting city that is Siena on a walking tour and discover why it is considered one of the most beautiful and vibrant cities in Tuscany. Relax by the pool in the afternoon. (B)

Day 10 – 18 May – San Gimignano and Volterra

After breakfast head to the Tuscan countryside. Your first stop is the medieval village of San Gimignano, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that's located an hour away from Florence. It's famous for its historic buildings, Vernaccia wine, and award-winning gelaterias. Explore the beautiful squares, palaces, and churches of the city on a private guided tour before grabbing a coffee in an open-air cafe. The tour continues in Volterra, located in the east side of the province of Pisa, on the borderline of the province of Siena, and is situated on a hill 1770 feet above the sea level. Its origins date back to the ancient Etruscans. The Etruscan walls are still visible, well preserved and surround the city centre. Furthermore, you can really feel a medieval atmosphere when walking through the narrow streets of the centre. (B)

Day 11 – 19 May - Siena Late in the morning reach a local winery for wine tasting and lunch. Free afternoon. (B,L)

Day 12 – 20 May - Siena to Florence After breakfast travel to Florence. Check in at your hotel and in the afternoon don't miss a single one of Florence's best sights as you have free time to explore the Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, and many more. Discover the city of the Mighty Medici family.
