Albany

Day 1: 04 March 2027

ARRIVAL & WELCOME TO ALBANY EXPERIENCE

This afternoon we kick things off with our Welcome to Albany Walking & Wine Tasting Tour!

From the Visitors Centre we walk to Alison Hartman Gardens and learn about the indigenous, the Menang. Their sustainable actions have preserved the wild spaces on the south coast around Albany for tens of thousands of years. Learn about Albany's history, its historic buildings and architecture and the people that left their mark on the town.

We then will find ourselves on the edge of Princess Royal Harbour where we relax with a Great Southern Wine tasting at Alkoomi Wines Cellar Door.

After our tour we have made dinner reservations at Satao if you'd like to join us (own expense)

*For those arriving by air, we will have transport waiting for us to take us to our accommodation. Those that are driving, please arrive at the hotel no later than 2pm for check in.

Day 2: 05 March 2027

BREMER BAY ORCA TOUR

We have a BIG day ahead and an early start! Sit back and relax as we drive 2 hours to Bremer Bay. Departing the harbour our journey to the heart of the

hunting grounds is only 19 nautical miles from the coast and a short one-hour trip. The journey to The Patch as the hunting grounds are known is the perfect time to spot the transition of wildlife as we move from Bremer Bay into offshore feeding grounds for an incredible congregation of wildlife including offshore seabirds such as albatross, shearwaters and petrels along with dolphins, seals and sharks. Arriving in The Patch a team of onboard researchers and scientists begin the search for Orca as everyone onboard joins in on that incredible moment of the first sighting of the day. The Orca (aka Killer Whales) are often sighted within moments of arriving as the area comes alive with the energy of the ocean's apex predator. We'll be introduced to each Orca that approaches the vessel and educated on their name, personality, and role within that particular family pod. During our day with the Killer Whales, we will observe them foraging, socialising, and hunting in the waters of the Bremer Canyons.

After such a big day, we'll head back to our hotel and have dinner at our hotel (own expense)

Day 3- 06 March 2027

GRANITE SKYWALK PORONGURUPS

Today we explore the natural beauty

and rich heritage of the Porongurups!

Our day will start with a 4.2 km return hike to Castle Rock. This hike does require a moderate level of fitness and will include 2.2 km of uphill hiking on uneven surfaces, a rock scramble and ladder climb but we promise it'll all be worth the effort! We'll also experience the Granite Skywalk- an award-winning platform suspended above the treetops offering breath-taking views of the ocean.

Afterwards we enjoy lunch and savour the wine of a local winery!

This evening we'll have our sunset Farewell Dinner and reminisce about the last few days we've spent together!

Day 4: 07 March 2027

DEPARTURE -THE GAP & NATURAL WONDERS

This morning we'll head to Torndirrup National Park and visit the rugged coastline including the iconic Gap, Natural Bridge and Stoney Hill.

We'll complete our journey and exploration of the impressive coastline relaxing with scones, jam & cream overlooking King George Sound, perched at the waters' edge.

For those flying home with us, our tour will conclude with a drop off at the airport. For others, your drop off at the hotel will be approx. 1pm.
